



#### DOMAINE DU GRAPILLON D'OR


The year 1806 is carved into one of the stones above a door at this domaine, indicating its founding. Since taking over from her father in 2000, Céline Chauvet has steadily modernized the estate, while keeping quality high. She welcomes visitors at a shiny new tasting room, which has a wonderful corkscrew collection on display.

Today, the estate totals 39 acres of vines, nearly all of which run along the Les Garrigues plateau below the town. All of the plantings are Grenache or Syrah—there's no Mourvèdre or Cinsault, a rarity for Gigondas. This is a very traditional domaine, with vinification in cement vat and aging in *foudre*. There is one exception, though, as Chauvet was among the first to destem entirely.

Of the two bottlings, the basic Gigondas displays the charm, finesse and bright mineral edge Chauvet aims for, while her Excellence cuvée draws on the estate's oldest vines to deliver a slightly darker fruit profile and more overt chalky structure.

Gigondas, a former Côtes du Rhône designation, became its own appellation in 1971. It lies at the foot of the Dentelles de Montmirail, a small mountain chain with teethlike topography. The Dentelles limit morning sunshine, prolonging grape maturation, and bring the limestone to the vineyards, mixed with some clay and sand. The reds are concentrated but have finesse, showing floral, perfumy notes with dark fruit, spice and mineral flavors.
